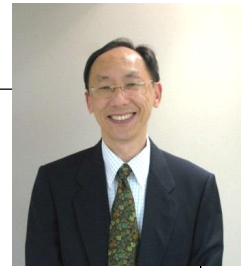

Our School is going through challenging times when the Audit Commission raised the public's doubts about DSS' management in finance and staffing while the Education Bureau defended its administration's limitation as being toothless. Parents are seen communicating closely with School to provide the public valued transparency and accountability towards clarifying these confusions. This is the kind of circumstances where parent managers provide crucial input to the School's Incorporate Management Committee (IMC) with regard to parents' perception of the scenario, to students' concern of School's reputation, and the desired direction for the School.
